

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE**

**BUSINESS HOURS:** The office is open from 8:00 AM to 5 PM Monday thru Friday. The Plant Department hours are 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM.

**TERMS:** Discover, Master Card, Visa or Net 30 Days for approved credit accounts. Customers in good credit standing may charge their orders. Other customers must pre-pay for their order at time of booking, by cash, check or credit card. A finance charge of 2% per month is added to invoices over 30 days from ship date. This equates to 24% annually. A minimum charge of \$1.00 per assessment is added on overdue accounts. Returned check charge is \$25.00. All custom orders and special orders are payable in advance.

**PRICES:** All prices quoted are F.O.B. Grower, unless otherwise indicated. Prices are for plant(s) only and do not include Royalty Charges, Patent Fees, Boxing Charges, etc. Prices are subject to change without notice. Prices at time of shipment will prevail. Typographical or clerical errors in quotation, orders or invoices are subject to correction.

**SALES TAX:** Appropriate state tax will be charged on all items unless we have your completed sales tax exempt form. In compliance with the law, we must charge sales tax on all items which the state designates as taxable even though you have provided us with a completed sales tax form.

**LIABILITY:** All recommendations by Maryland Plants & Supplies, Inc. and its employee's are compiled from recognized Horticultural sources. Because conditions of use which are of critical importance are beyond our control, we make no warranty or representation, expressed or implied, except that all products conform to the description of the label. ## **SHIPPING METHODS**

### **SHIPMENTS BY MARYLAND PLANTS & SUPPLIES, INC. OR GROWER TRUCK**

Selected growers' plant material can be shipped by grower truck or Maryland Plants & Supplies, Inc. truck for a nominal fee. This fee is usually a competitive fee when compared to UPS, Airfreight, or Federal Express, and normally is the most cost effective means of transportation. Unlike UPS, Federal Express and Airfreight, the plant materials are guaranteed to arrive in good shape or you can leave it on the truck. Plant material refused due to damage or poor quality will be deducted at the time of invoicing. Any damage claim or refusal must be reported immediately to our plant material department, then noted on the delivery ticket and signed by driver at time of delivery. For further information on the mode of transportation call our Plant Department. If concerns arise after delivery is made, contact our office within 24 hours of delivery so that your problems may be addressed.

### **SHIPMENTS BY UPS, FEDERAL EXPRESS AND AIRFREIGHT**

**No plant material freight carriers (UPS, Federal Express or Airfreight) issue credit for cold/heat damage.**

Growers who ship from cold areas of the country usually provide a winter protection packing to protect plant material. Call our office for further details.

UPS will not issue credit for mishandling plant material unless there is visible damage to the box which results in damage to the plant material. UPS is not often recommended by growers for shipment. Federal Express and Airfreight have a responsibility to handle boxes properly as designated on the outside of the box. ALL Federal Express and Airfreight shipments MUST be opened PRIOR to signing the bill of lading to inspect shipment BEFORE accepting. Any damages due to mishandling or delays in shipment MUST be noted in the presence of delivery representative on the bill of lading. Once damages have been noted, the delivery representative MUST sign the bill of lading and a claim can be filed by the CONSIGNEE (receiver of plants) for damages. ALL UPS, FEDERAL EXPRESS AND AIRFREIGHT SHIPMENTS ARE AT THE CUSTOMER'S RISK!

Maryland Plants & Supplies, Inc. is not able to process credit requests for plant material damaged in transit directly from the grower. The request for credit must be filed by the consignee (receiver of plants) directly with the carrier. The consignee is the only party who can file a claim with the carrier. The carrier will not allow Maryland Plants or the supplier to file the claim for them.

**— COLD WEATHER ALERT! —**

In an attempt to prevent any shipping problems relating to direct shipments of plant material (mishandling, delays or problems due to extreme temperatures), please review the following guidelines:

- It is crucial that all boxes be opened in the presence of the shipper or freight carrier to ensure that the plant material has not been damaged.
- If you sign without an inspection, you have accepted your delivery "in good condition" and have little recourse in the matter of filing a damage claim to recover any losses.
- NOTE: UPS and Federal Express will not issue credit for cold damage unless the transit time was increased, causing a delay.

## **STEPS TO FOLLOW UPON RECEIPT OF PLANT MATERIAL**

- 1. Do a visual check of boxes. Open boxes before signing anything! Check how long the order was in transit.** Are the boxes visibly damaged in any way? Open boxes in presence of delivery representative before signing. Try to determine severity of damage. Make note of damage and write "**extension of claim time requested for extent of damage to be assessed**" on receiving document and get it signed! If the material was delayed, open boxes before signing. Are plants cold baked or show signs of cold or heat damage? Try to determine severity of damage. Make note of damage and write "**extension of claim time requested for extent of damage to be assessed**" on receiving document and get it signed! **REMEMBER**, some problems such as cold damage may take some time to be apparent (claims valid only if shipment was delayed).
- 2. Within 24 hours from time of delivery, you must call and report your claim.** Most carriers will send a claim form which must be completed. **DO NOT THROW PLANTS OUT!** Some carriers will send a representative to inspect plants. A photograph taken of damaged plants is sometimes helpful in receiving credit. Please contact us if you have questions regarding your claim.
- 3. At the greenhouse, plants should be immediately unpacked and inspected.** Contact Maryland Plants & Supplies, Inc. immediately for any problems unrelated to shipping damage. We will promptly contact the grower to address any concerns. Maryland Plants & Supplies, Inc. and our growers stand behind the quality of the plants that you receive.

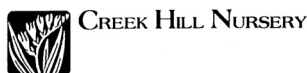
